Parking & Campus shuttle

Monday-Friday. Visitors to the Admission Information Center are welcome to park in Lot 23, which is located near the south end of campus.

When navigating to campus: Enter "80 Pyne Dr., Princeton, NJ." This will lead you to the south entrance at the intersection of Elm Drive and Faculty Road (a traffic circle).

Follow signs to Lot 23 to park and either walk to your destination or catch the free campus shuttle, Tiger Transit, which operates frequently from Lot 23. Take Tiger Transit shuttle number 4 to the Admission Information Center, located at 36 University Place.

Please note that the shuttle does not run on weekends.
